CELL Aquaculture has shipped its first batch of baby fish to its new operations in the Netherlands as part of its growth plans. The WA firm said the baby barramundi arrived with a “nil mortality rate” under its “hatch to dispatch” program. The Dutch facility will use Aquaculture’s technology and equipment to raise 50 tonne of fish per annum in a controlled environment. Initial sales of Australian barramundi to the European market are scheduled in the third quarter of 2006.
